





Avon is the newest and fastest growing community in the county with an expected growth of 14.1% in the next 5 years.

In 2017, Avon was selected by Money Magazine as the 17th best place to live in America. The community's website reports that Avon prides itself on being a "safe, vibrant community for active families and thriving businesses."

Unfortunately, Avon cannot boast of a vibrant faith community. Only 26% of the residents identify as Protestant and there is little to no reformed church presence. Because of this, the Central Indiana Presbytery is committed to planting a PCA church in the area with the support of the Midwest Alliance whose mission is to see PCA churches and presbyteries in the Midwest working together to plant and grow healthy and reproducing churches.
