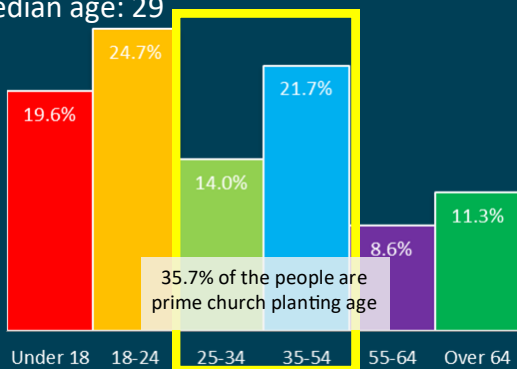

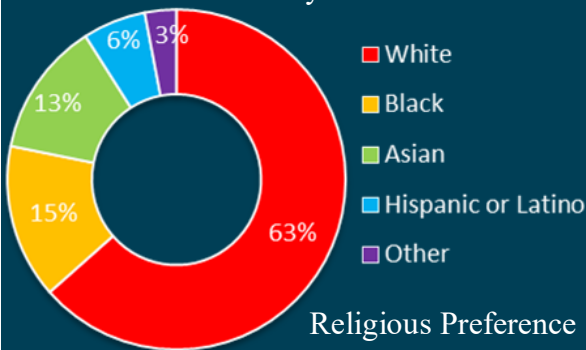

Age Demographics

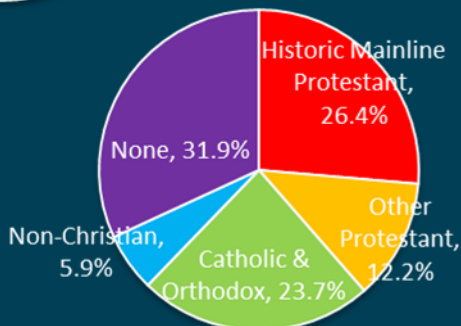

Religious Preference



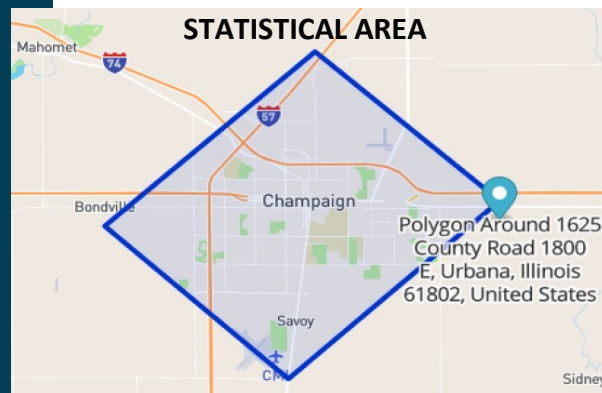

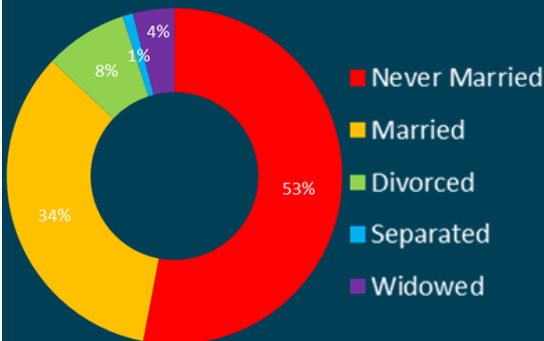
