




## Age Demographics Median age: 38

Davenport, Iowa is being transformed. The riverfront city has funding for a \$24 million “placemaking” investment.

According to Downtown Davenport, the ideal is to make “a generational impact on our quality of life and enhancing the likelihood of adjacent business growth, taxbase stability, and most importantly, people choosing to live or visit here.”

But, with only 44% of the people in Davenport identifying as Protestant, the Iowa Presbytery sees the city’s greatest need is the gospel. By God’s grace, the Presbytery intends to expand the reach of the gospel by planting a PCA church in Davenport.

The Presbytery foresees a healthy and growing, self-sustaining and self-governing PCA church characterized by vibrant Christ-centered worship, effective ministries of evangelism, mercy, and missions coupled with transformational fellowship and discipleship in Davenport all to the glory of God.

The Iowa Presbytery will also have the support of the Midwest Alliance. The hope is to see this church make disciples who will then help to spread the gospel, multiplying praise to God and planting churches throughout the region.


