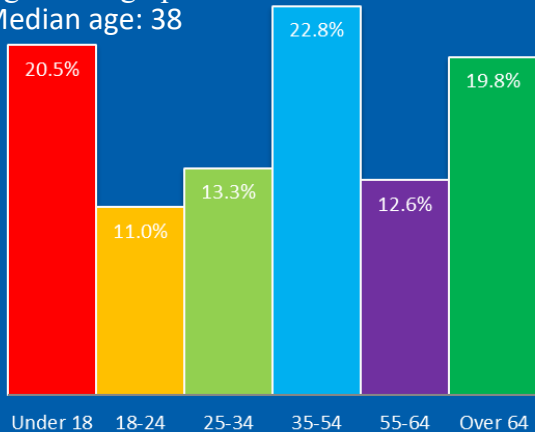

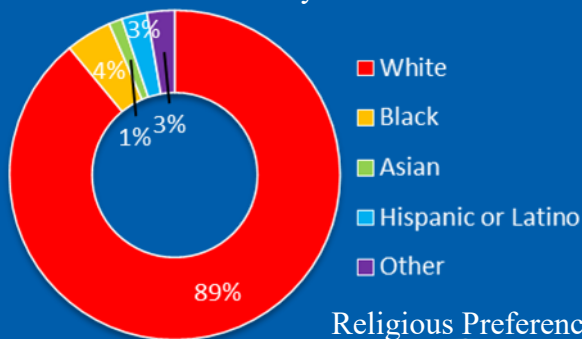

Age Demographics

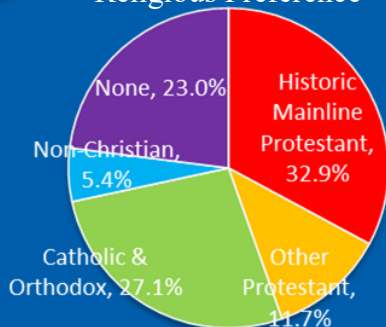

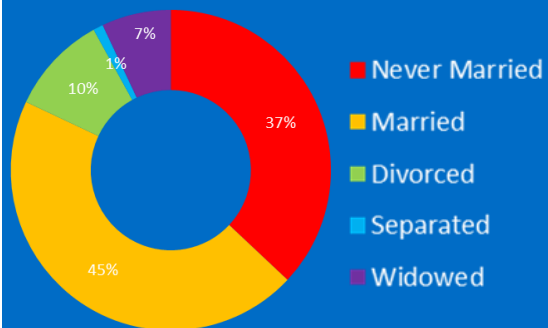
