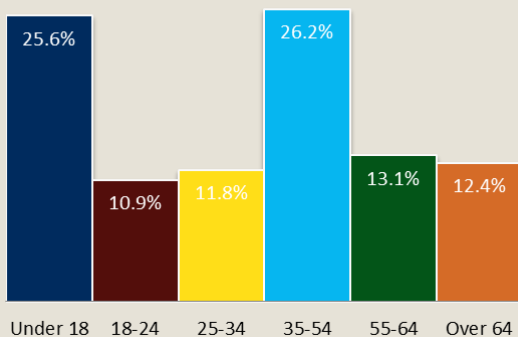

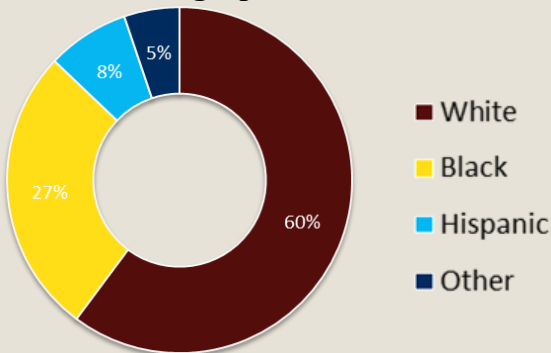

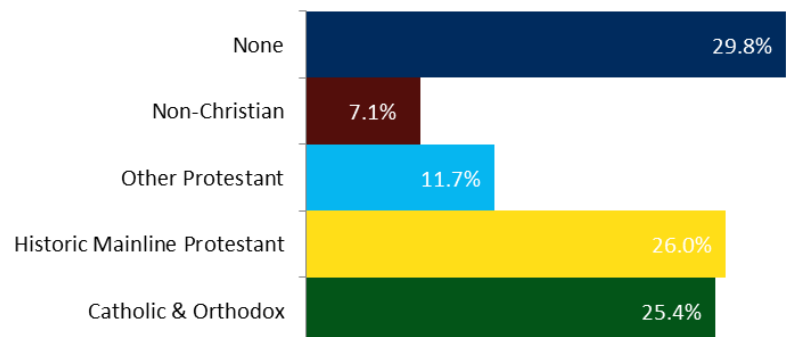
Those statistics drive the Central Indiana Presbytery's partnership with the Midwest Alliance to pursue church planting in this area.
