Portage, Wisconsin is the county seat and largest city

in Columbia County. At the split of the Wisconsin and Fox River, the city is surrounded by prairies and grasslands.

With over 60% of the population not involved in a church and little reformed influence, the opportunity to see lives changed by the gospel in Portage is immense.

A church planter in Portage would have the prayer and financial support of "On Wisconsin," the local church planting network.

The majority of churches in the Wisconsin Presbytery are invested in this network and its goal of planting 16 more churches in Wisconsin in 10 years.

Since 2012, 5 churches have taken root, 5 new works have started and 2 RUF chapters have begun.

By the grace of God, a church in Portage will soon be added to those numbers.

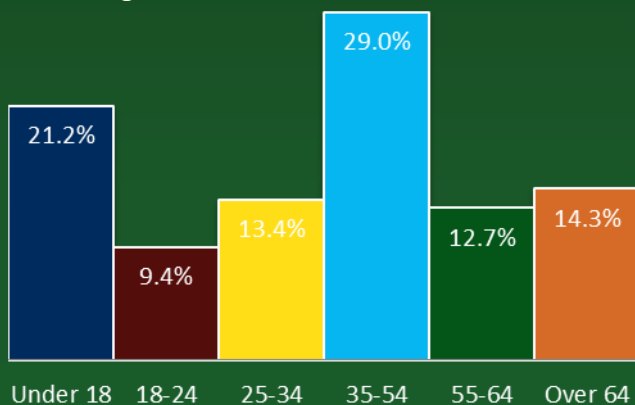

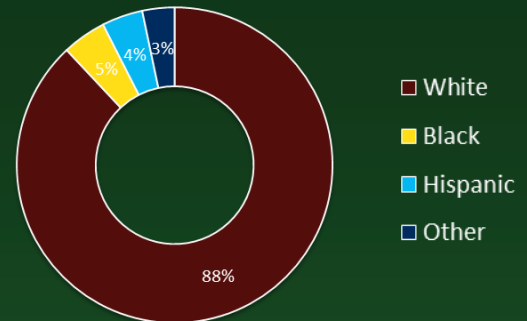

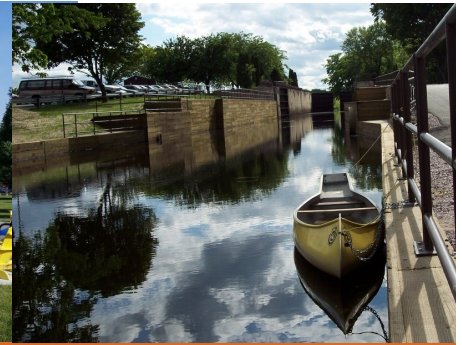
