Windsor is located in southwestern Ontario, Canada on the

south bank of the Detroit River, directly across from Detroit, Michigan. The city's website provides a link to their 20 year vision that includes lowering unemployment, economic restructuring to combat the decline of the manufacturing sector, and developing a healthy environment. They



also describe Windsor as "an incredible community that offers world-class entertainment, fascinating historical and cultural landmarks, and unparalleled waterfront parks and gardens" and "a city committed to being a creative and vibrant destination that encourages artistic expression and celebrates cultural identity and diversity."

Unfortunately, less than 25% of the population identifies as Protestant. Given the statistics, Great Lakes Presbytery's vision is, with God's grace, to plant the first PCA church in Windsor.

disciples who will then help to spread the gospel, multiplying praise to God and planting churches throughout the region.




Highlights

- About ten minutes from Detroit, Michigan.
- Windsor had historical flooding in 2016, 2017 and 2019.


